Take and pass the <a href="#">Minnesota Teacher License Examinations (MTLE) Special Education Content Tests</a> (you don't need to take the Pedagogy Tests again).	
Complete an <a href="#">Application to Add a Field to an Existing Minnesota License</a> . Return to MDE Licensing with the \$62.70 fee.
